Lacy Davis' dream came true a little over a year ago when she opened Healing Hearts Home Health, becoming its CEO/RN Administrator.



"It has always been a dream of mine to own my own home health," Lacy said. "I started in home health when I was 15 years old. I couldn't even drive; my boss drove me around. I was a CNA while going to nursing school and worked in home health as a staff nurse, Director of Nursing and Administrator. I literally 'grew up' in home health."

The company provides skilled and non-skilled home health care services. This includes helping keep patients safe and providing training on how patients can best take care of themselves at home. The company is Medicare-certified and accredited through the Accreditation Commission for Health Care.

Healing Hearts currently has 15 employees and is looking for more RNs. In addition to registered nurses, the employees include physical therapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, home health aides and medical social workers. They serve patients of all ages, from pediatric to geriatric.

"I decided to go into business because I saw the need and the benefits for home health," Lacy said. "I am able to give the care that I want all of my patients to experience, which is simply being treated like family. Our motto is to care for all patients as we would want our own family cared for: 'Where your family is our family.'"

Lacy's goal is for her company to be the number one choice for home health. She also wants to continue to give back to the communities that she serves by providing education seminars and free toenail clinics and by participating in community events.

"Continuing to keep up with education and health demands is a big goal," she said. "All my staff will be updated and educated on the latest practices. We encourage staff to participate in education opportunities as much as possible."

Lacy heard about the FUEL Business Incubator and its Outreach Memberships from another local business owner and realized it would be a good place to have meetings. And she found that it was much more than that.
